



# Activity: Red Light Green Light

Students responses will present wonderful discussion on public policy.*

## Materials Needed:

- A card set per student consisting of a red and a green card.

## Directions:

- Pass out the card sets to each student.
- State that you will read the following statements and if the students feel it is a public policy to hold up their green card and if it is not a public policy to hold up their red card.
- You can easily come up with statements that are related to your specific class. Some sample statements include:
  - Students shouldn't run with scissors.
  - Students and teachers should turn off lights when they leave the room.
  - Don't go swimming right after eating.
  - President Bush tells all Americans to pull together.
  - No shirts, no shoes, no service.
